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The Union Health Ministry outlined a phased expansion to upgrade district hospital emergency care under Union Budget 2026-27 commitments, alongside key indigenous defence deliveries and market stability measures.

COMBINED SUMMARY

- Health Ministry categorised 613 District Hospitals for phased 50% emergency care capacity expansion under IPHS guidelines.
- Indian Navy received Samarthak, its first indigenous Multi-Purpose Vessel built by L&T Kattupalli with over 75% local content.
- National Security Guard launched the 1st Mahila Commando Conversion Course at Manesar for CAPF and State Police women officers.
- Government expanded onion buffer distribution via rail rakes under the Kanda Express initiative to stabilise retail prices.

1. DISTRICT HOSPITAL EMERGENCY CARE UPGRADE UNION BUDGET**WHY IN NEWS**

- Union Health Ministry reviewed the implementation of Union Budget 2026-27 commitments to increase emergency and trauma care capacity in District Hospitals by 50%.

WHAT IS THE INITIATIVE?

- A national health infrastructure initiative to strengthen Emergency and Trauma Care Centres across District Hospitals.
- Utilises gap analysis based on Indian Public Health Standards (IPHS) to evaluate baseline facility readiness, human resources, and digital integration.

PHASES AND IMPLEMENTATION DETAILS

- Covers 613 District Hospitals in three distinct phases based on patient load and structural readiness.
- Phase I targets 160 District Hospitals for completion by March 2027, Phase II covers 203 hospitals, and Phase III will upgrade the remaining 250.

- Integrates National Emergency Life Support (NELS) training to enhance clinical competencies of healthcare personnel.

WHY IT MATTERS

- Addresses secondary healthcare bottlenecks by reducing referral burdens on tertiary institutions like AIIMS.
- Standardises public emergency care networks through unified digital pre-hospital integration and IPHS benchmarks.

2. INS SAMARTHAK INDIGENOUS MULTI PURPOSE VESSEL

WHY IN NEWS

- Larsen & Toubro delivered Samarthak, the Indian Navy's first indigenous Multi-Purpose Vessel (MPV), at Kattupalli.

WHAT IS THE VESSEL?

- Samarthak ('The Proponent') is the first in a new class of specialized Multi-Purpose Vessels designed for the Indian Navy.
- Achieves over 75% indigenous content, reflecting domestic shipbuilding capacity under defense indigenisation policies.

KEY CAPABILITIES AND ROLES

- Functions primarily as a trial and evaluation platform for weapons and sensors.
- Engineered to support secondary roles including maritime surveillance, reconnaissance, offshore patrolling, and Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) operations.

KEY TERMS

- **Multi-Purpose Vessel:** A naval platform designed with flexible modular architecture to execute diverse operational tasks rather than a single tactical mission.

3. NSG MAHILA COMMANDO CONVERSION COURSE MANESAR

WHY IN NEWS

- National Security Guard operationalised its 1st Mahila Commando Conversion Course (MCCC) at the NSG Training Academy in Manesar.

WHAT IS THE COURSE?

- A specialized conversion training program establishing an all-women commando capability within elite counter-terrorism units.

- Inducts selected female personnel from Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) and State Police Forces into elite tactical roles.

TRAINING ARCHITECTURE

- Focuses on advanced tactical intervention, hostage rescue operations, close-quarter combat, and counter-terrorism modules.
- Standardises tactical capability across Central and State security forces through centralised training at Manesar.

4. KANDA EXPRESS BUFFER STOCK ONION INTERVENTION

WHY IN NEWS

- Department of Consumer Affairs initiated calibrated market intervention releasing buffer stock onions at ₹35/kg via mobile outlets and rail logistics.

WHAT IS THE MECHANISM?

- Targeted market intervention scheme executed through Price Stabilisation Fund (PSF) mechanisms to curb retail food inflation.
- Buffer stocks managed by Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC), NAFED, and NCCF are deployed to demand centers.

ROLE OF KANDA EXPRESS LOGISTICS

- Utilises dedicated Indian Railways rakes ('Kanda Express') for bulk transport from key producing regions to major consumption urban centers.
- Scaled up movement from 12,000 MT (14 rakes) in 2024-25 to 88,000 MT (86 rakes to 16 cities) in 2025-26, lowering freight transport costs compared to road transit.

KEY TERMS

- **Price Stabilisation Fund:** A central fund set up to absorb price volatility of essential agricultural commodities through strategic buffer procurement and market release.

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PRELIMS FACTS

Price Stabilisation Fund operates under the Department of Consumer Affairs to manage perishables.
