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Anthropological Approaches To The Study Of Religion

Definition

Refers to the practice of alternating between two or more languages or language varieties within a single conversation or discourse.

Thinkers

A.R. Radcliffe-Brown - structural-functionalism: institutions function like organs to maintain social structure. E.B. Tylor - culture is that complex whole which includes knowledge, belief, art, morals, law, custom; unilinear evolution and survivals.

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
