Author of Manucharitram and chief poet among the Ashtadiggajas at Krishnadeva Raya's court.

Ashtadiggajas

Traditional set of eight great Telugu poets said to have adorned the Vijayanagara court.

Andhra Bhoja

Honorific comparing the king to Bhoja of Dhara as a learned royal patron.
