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Partition of Bengal 1905

Administrative split that nationalists treated as a political amputation; annulled in 1911.

Indian Universities Act 1904

Curzon-era law increasing government control over university governance.

Swadeshi movement

Boycott and national education campaign that massified Bengal politics after 1905.

Calcutta Corporation

Municipal reform that cut Indian representation in the imperial capital.

1911 reunification

Bengal was reunited and the capital moved to Delhi; the political scar remained.

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
