Article 19(1)(a)-(c)

Speech, assembly and association rights that lawful farmers' protests and unions rely on, subject to reasonable restrictions.

National Commission on Farmers (Swaminathan)

Recommended a comprehensive farmer policy, including an MSP related to weighted cost; a frequent demand in union charters.

Farm laws, 2020, repealed 2021

Three Union statutes on trade, contract farming and essential commodities were repealed after nationwide farmer mobilisation.

National Food Security Act, 2013

Legal entitlement to subsidised grain; farm organisations also lobby procurement that feeds the NFSA pool.

Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005

Rural wage floor that farm households use in the lean season; often part of agrarian demand charters.
