Nehru moved the Objective Resolution in the Constituent Assembly; it was adopted in January 1947.

Preamble

Justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity in the Preamble follow the Resolution's aims, later adding socialist, secular, and integrity by amendment.

Safeguards

The Resolution expressly included minorities, tribal areas, and depressed classes, which shaped reservation and cultural-rights debates.
