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First Amendment, 1951

Articles 31A and 31B and the Ninth Schedule were inserted to protect zamindari abolition and related agrarian laws.

Twenty-fifth Amendment, 1971

Article 31C protected laws giving effect to Articles 39(b) and (c) from challenge under Articles 14, 19, and 31.

Forty-fourth Amendment, 1978

The right to property ceased to be a fundamental right and was recast as Article 300A.

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
