Waltz 1979

Bipolarity reduces uncertainty; each superpower balances the other without depending on allies to the same degree.

NATO and Warsaw Pact

The two Cold War alliances that organised the bipolar military map in Europe.

Deutsch and Singer

Argued that a larger number of poles can increase interaction and spread attention, a rival stability claim.
