1991 reforms

Look East

Early 1990s outreach to ASEAN that later thickened into Act East and connectivity.

1998 tests

Pokhran-II declared nuclear-weapon status, then sanctions, then a long bargain toward civilian nuclear trade.

India-US 123 path

Civil nuclear cooperation in the 2000s that broke decades of technology denial.
