**Panchsheel 1954**

India-China statement of five principles, including peaceful coexistence, later cited across NAM.

**Bandung 1955**

Asian-African Conference that universalised coexistence language for newly independent States.

**UN Charter**

Sovereign equality and peaceful settlement that Indian diplomats treat as the legal home of the doctrine.

**Ladakh 2020**

Border crisis with China that forced India to pair coexistence talk with military and Quad hedging.
