(a) China. Cross-strait and South China Sea issues are not labelled the **two-state solution**. This is not the key.

(b) Official key

(b) Israel. **(b) Official key:** The **two-state solution** means an independent Palestine alongside Israel, roughly on **1967 lines** with negotiated swaps. That is the stored key.

(c)

(c) Iraq. Iraq's federal and sectarian settlement is not the two-state formula in this usage. This is not the key.

(d)

(d) Yemen. Yemen's war is not framed as a **two-state solution**. This is not the key.

Summary

Official key is (b) Israel. In diplomacy the **two-state solution** is the Israel-Palestine track. China, Iraq and Yemen refer to other conflicts. Honour the stored letter (b).
