Explanation

(a)

All parties in government. Coalition, not the definition.

(b) Official key

Government responsible to the Parliament (Lok Sabha). Collective responsibility.

(c)

Elected and removable by the people directly. That is a presidential/recall mix.

(d)

Chosen by Parliament but fixed term. That denies **no-confidence**.

Summary

Official key is (b). Parliamentary government means the Council of Ministers is responsible to the popular House and can be removed by it. It is not a national-front cabinet, a direct recall, or a fixed-term executive.
