Explanation

(a)

1 and 2 only. Hague in this list is not the CWC/BWC pair as stated; Under2 is climate, not child rights.

(b)

4 only. Under2 Coalition is subnational climate, not children.

(c) Official key

1 and 3 only. Alma-Ata (1978) is primary health care; Talanoa Dialogue is the UNFCCC climate process. Hague and Under2 are mis-paired.

(d)

2, 3 and 4 only. Keeps two wrong pairs.

Summary

Official key is (c) 1 and 3 only. Alma-Ata is health for all; Talanoa is climate. The Hague Convention here is not keyed as chemical/biological weapons, and Under2 is a climate coalition of subnational governments, not child rights.
