(b)

2 only. Under-counts Preamble and Duties.

(c)

1 and 3 only. DPSPs also hold.

(d) Official key

1, 2 and 3. Preamble, Directive Principles and Fundamental Duties all reflect UDHR principles besides the Fundamental Rights chapter.

Summary

Official key is (d) all three. Besides Part III, the Preamble, Part IV and **Part IVA** are keyed as reflecting Universal Declaration of Human Rights ideas - dignity, social security, duties to the community.
