Explanation**(a) Official key**

1 only. Broach (Bharuch) had an early EIC factory. Chicacole and Trichinopoly were not first-quarter-17th-century EIC factories.

(b)

1 and 2. Chicacole (Srikakulam) is later/other European.

(c)

3 only. Trichinopoly is inland later Carnatic.

(d)

2 and 3. Both miss the date and the map.

Summary

Official key is (a) 1 only. In the first quarter of the seventeenth century the English East India Company was on the west-coast factories (Surat, Broach). Chicacole and Trichinopoly are not that list.

Related possible facts

These can be asked in a future Prelims paper.

Surat factory

1613; the EIC's first lasting foothold.

Broach / Bharuch

Narmada mouth; early 17th-c. English factory.
