Explanation**(a) Official key**

Ajanta in the **Waghora** gorge. Correct.

(b)

Sanchi on the Chambal. Sanchi is on a hill near the Betwa, not a Chambal gorge.

(c)

Pandu-lena on the Narmada. Nashik caves on a hill, not Narmada gorge.

(d)

Amaravati on the Godavari. **Amaravati** is on the Krishna.

Summary

Official key is (a). Ajanta's caves cut the **Waghora** river gorge. Sanchi, Pandu-lena (Nashik) and **Amaravati** sit on other rivers or hills.

Waghora

The stream at Ajanta; waterfall in the monsoon.

Amaravati

Krishna valley; Mahachaitya.
