Explanation

(a)

Only one pair. Two dynasty tags hold.

(b) Official key

Only two pairs. Nannuka-Chandela and Nagabhata II-Gurjara-Pratihara. Jayashakti is Chandela, not Paramara; the famous Bhoja is Paramara, not Rashtrakuta.

(c)

Only three pairs. Two names are swapped across houses.

(d)

All four. Two mismatches.

Summary

Official key is (b) only two pairs. Nannuka founded the Chandela line; Nagabhata II is Gurjara-Pratihara. Jayashakti is a Chandela, not Paramara. Raja Bhoja of Dhara is Paramara, not Rashtrakuta.

Paramara of Malwa; Bhojshala / Bhojpur.
