Goa has the largest floating solar photovoltaic project in India. Which of the statements given above is/are correct? (a) 1 and 2 (b) 2 only (c) 1 and 3 (d) 3 only
Official key: B.

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Explanation

(a)

1 and 2. **Bhadla** (Rajasthan) has been the largest solar park, not Gujarat as a blanket.

(b) Official key

2 only. Cochin International Airport is fully solar-powered. Goa is not India's largest floating PV.

(c)

1 and 3. Both superlatives fail.

(d)

3 only. Floating PV leadership has been elsewhere (e.g. Ramagundam / other NTPC sites).

Summary

Official key is (b) 2 only. **CIAL** (Kochi) runs as a fully solar-powered airport. The largest solar park tag has sat with Rajasthan's **Bhadla**, not Gujarat as stated; India's largest floating solar is not keyed to Goa.
