Explanation

(a)

Only one. All three pairings are wrong.

(b)

Only two. None of the three habitats match.

(c)

All three. **Indri** is Madagascar, elk is not Indonesia's flagship, **bonobo** is Congo.

(d) Official key

None. Brazil-**Indri**, Indonesia-Elk, Madagascar-**Bonobo** are all mismatches.

Summary

Official key is (d) none. **Indri** is a lemur of Madagascar, not Brazil. Elk (wapiti) is a Holarctic deer, not an Indonesian endemic. **Bonobo** is a great ape of the **Congo basin**, not Madagascar. Zero pairs match.

Related possible facts

These can be asked in a future Prelims paper.

Indri

Largest living lemur; Madagascar only.

Bonobo

Pan paniscus; south of the Congo River.
