Inter-State trade and commerce as a State List head. It is Union List (entry 42).

(b)

Inter-State migration as a State List head. Migration and quarantine are Union List (entry 81).

(c) Official key

Inter-State quarantine is a Union subject. That is the correctly placed row.

(d)

Corporation tax as a State List head. Corporation tax is Union List (entry 85).

Summary

Official key is (c). **Seventh Schedule Union List entry 81** is inter-State migration and inter-State quarantine. Trade and commerce between States, and corporation tax, are also Union, not State. So only (c) is a correct constitutional placement.
